# September 11 (Mon.) – December 15 (Fri.) Kanazawa University

## Overview

Kanazawa University September-December Program (KUSDP) is a newly developed program starting in 2017 at Kanazawa University. The program this year starts on September 11 (Mon.) and ends on December 15 (Fri.).

KUSDP offers Japanese language classes, lectures on Japanese culture and society, and independent research on a topic of a student's interest in the field of Japanese culture and society. For further information, please see the tentative calendar in a separate file.

#### **Enrollment**

Up to 10 students

#### Tuition

Tuition shall be waived for the number of students specified in the MOU between the student's home institution and Kanazawa University.

## Japan Student Service Organization (JASSO) Scholarship – JPY 80,000/month

All participants in this program will receive a monthly stipend of 80,000 yen for the duration of this program (4 months) from the Japan Student Service Organization (JASSO). ### Eligibility

Applicants must satisfy all of the following requirements. They...

- 1. must be currently enrolled in the undergraduate program at partner universities of Kanazawa University,
- 2. are in good academic standing,
- 3. have a clear purpose for study aboard and have a full intention to devote themselves to academic

and other cultural programs,

- 4. go back to their home universities and continue their education after the finishing the program,
- 5. should be able to obtain appropriate visa status in Japan,
- 6. should be proficient in English in order to understand lectures,
- 7. have studied Japanese language for at least one year in their home institution or equivalent (e.g., N5 in JLPT), and
- 8. are in good health.

#### APPLICATION FOR KUSDP

Step 1: Fill out the application form and prepare additional documents\*.

- \*An official or unofficial transcript from your home institution (PDF format)
- \*Your ID photo (3cm × 4cm) in JPEG or other digital format
- \*A photocopy of the ID page of your passport (PDF format)
- \*Agreement for Defraying Expenses with Statement of Bank Account Balance (Students applying for this program should enclose bank balance verifying that they have JPY500, 000 of funds equipment.)
- \*\*If you had also applied Program A and already sent all of additional documents, you can apply by submitting only application form.
- <u>Step 2</u>: Submit the completed application materials to the international office of your home institution. Note that we only accept application through your home institution. Application by an individual student will not be processed.

Step 3: Your home institution will send your application materials by the following deadline:

Application Deadline: May 31 (Wed.), 2017

#### **Notification of Acceptance**

Kanazawa University will notify the international office of your home institution of acceptance to the program in the end of June. Upon being notified of acceptance, you should prepare the following documents\*\* and submit them to Kanazawa University, again, via the international office of your home institution.

\*\*An original copy of the Health Certificate in the Kanazawa University format

#### Visa
